

Report of the Water Commissioners of The North Raynham Water District May 18,2023

To the Citizens of the North Raynham Water District

The Commissioners of the North Raynham Water District respectfully submit the following report of the operation and financial statement.

4 (Four) new services were installed giving the district 1426 active services.

The District pumped a total of 120.467 million gallons of water during 2022.

The Treasurer's report shows that the District is in sound financial condition. This has been confirmed by the independent auditor's report from Marcum Accountants LLP for the Fiscal Year 2022

The System Development and the District's Money Market Accounts, Certificates of Deposits and Capital Savings Accounts have yielded a total of \$28,677.00 in interest for Fiscal Year 2022.

The Demand Fees for new water installations generated \$2,895.00 for the Fiscal Year 2022. The System Development Fees generated \$36,335.00 for the Fiscal Year 2022.

District Annual Water Quality Reports

The annual water quality reports will be mailed to each resident by the required Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) July 1st deadline.

Major Infrastructure Changes

The district in cooperation with MassDOT, would like to upgrade the water main on Broadway. A relocation is required, and in anticipation of a future water filtration plant, the district would like to upgrade some of the new system to a 12" water main. This would replace an almost 75-year-old water main and would carry the district forward for the next 100 plus year. The MassDot informed the District on March 8,2023 that it would be withdrawing the offer to install the piping. A meeting was held on March 9, 2023, with a two article warrant and was postponed indefinitely.

New Meter Replacement Program

The district is continuing a system wide meter replacement program, installing the new radio read meters. District employees will be going door to door asking residents to allow entry to replace the old-style meters. There is no charge for this change out. Please call for an appointment @ 508-824-0520. The district has replaced 29 meters during 2022 bringing the total number of meters replaced to 1,193 which represents 85.3% of residential accounts and 84.5% of commercial accounts. This increases the accuracy of water readings which helps to reduce the districts unaccounted for water and lowers the tax rate due to more accurate consumption billing
