



**Report of the Water Commissioners
of The
North Raynham Water District
May 25, 2017**

To the Citizens of the North Raynham Water District

The Commissioners of the North Raynham Water District respectfully submit the following report of the operation and financial statement.

Two new services were installed giving the District 1,402 active services.

The District pumped a total of 135,980,000 gallons of water during 2016.

The Treasurer's report shows the District to be in sound financial condition. This has been confirmed by the independent auditor's report from Marcum Accountants LLP for the Fiscal Year 2016.

The System Development and the District's Money Market Accounts, Certificates of Deposits and Capital Savings Accounts have yielded a total of \$18,969.00 in interest for Fiscal Year 2016

The Demand Fees for new water installations generated \$13,168.00 for the Fiscal Year 2016. The System Development Fees generated \$30,625.00 for the Fiscal Year 2016.

District Annual Water Quality Reports

The annual water quality reports will be mailed to each resident by the required Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) July 1st deadline.

Major Infrastructure Changes

The District has completed a 2 year upgrading of electrical components at the pumping stations to improve efficiency and reduce electrical costs.

New Meter Replacement Program

The District has begun a system wide meter replacement program, installing the new radio read meters. District employees will be going door to door asking residents to allow entry to replace the old style meters. There is no charge for this change out. **Please call for an appointment @ 508-824-0520.** The District has replaced over 163 meters during 2016 bringing the total number of meters replaced to 672, which represents 52% of residential accounts. This increases the accuracy of water readings which helps to reduce the districts unaccounted for water and lowers the tax rate due to more accurate consumption billing.
