

## Report of the Water Commissioners of The North Raynham Water District June 25, 2020

To the Citizens of the North Raynham Water District

## The Commissioners of the North Raynham Water District respectfully submit the following report of the operation and financial statement.

Two new services were installed giving the District 1415 active services.

The District pumped a total of 118,491.000 gallons of water during 2019.

The Treasurer's report shows the District to be in sound financial condition. This has been confirmed by the independent auditor's report from Marcum Accountants LLP for the Fiscal Year 2019.

The System Development and the District's Money Market Accounts, Certificates of Deposits and Capital Savings Accounts have yielded a total of \$28,757.00 in interest for Fiscal Year 2019

The Demand Fees for new water installations generated \$6,590.00 for the Fiscal Year 2019. The System Development Fees generated \$11,655.00 for the Fiscal Year 2019.

## **District Annual Water Quality Reports**

The annual water quality reports will be mailed to each resident by the required Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) July 1st deadline.

**Major Infrastructure Changes** 

The District has painted and repaired the Wilbur Street Standpipe. This project was completed on September 15, 2018. Pictures will be posted on the District website @ www.nrwd.org Warranty work on the standpipe will take place in the fall of 2020, and should take about 2 to 3 weeks to complete.

New Meter Replacement Program

The District is continuing a system wide meter replacement program, installing the new radio read meters. District employees will be going door to door asking residents to allow entry to replace the old style meters. There is no charge for this change out. Please call for an appointment @ 508-824-0520. The District has replaced over 139 meters during 2019 bringing the total number of meters replaced to 1008, which represents 71% of residential accounts. This increases the accuracy of water readings which helps to reduce the districts unaccounted for water and lowers the tax rate due to more accurate consumption billing

**Bristol County Retirement System** 

The District officially became a member of the Bristol County Retirement System on July 1, 2019.
