In the name of the COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants and voters of that part of the TOWN OF RAYNHAM residing in the territory and included within the boundaries of the NORTH RAYNHAM WATER DISTRICT qualified to vote in elections to meet at the Raynham Senior Center located at 2215 King Philip Street Raynham, Massachusetts on Thursday, the 21st of May two-thousand and twenty - six at seven o'clock P.M. for the following purpose to wit:

- ARTICLE 1 To see if the District will vote to accept the reports of the Water Commissioners and the District Treasurer or take any action relative there to.
- ARTICLE 2 To Elect one member of the Board of Water Commissioners for a three (3) yr. term.
- ARTICLE 3 To Elect one member of the Board of Water Commissioners to complete a one (1)year Term to fulfill a vacancy.
- ARTICLE 4 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,061,647.00 for the Operations Funds of the North Raynham Water District for the fiscal year July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027 according to the budget or take any action relative thereto.
- ARTICLE 5 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$654,095.83 for the Wage Funds of the North Raynham Water District for the fiscal year July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027 according to the budget or take any action relative thereto.
- ARTICLE 6 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$262,293.63 for the Principal and Interest payment on the Arrowhead Filtration Plant Debt or take any action relative thereto.
- ARTICLE 7 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of 134,219.93 for the Principal and Interest payment on the Britton/Broadway Main Replacement Debt or take any action relative thereto.
- ARTICLE 8 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of 525,000.00 for the Emergency Fund or take any action relative thereto.
- ARTICLE 9 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$20,000.00 for the Reserve Fund or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 19 To see if the District will vote to accept grant funds in the amount of \$250,000.00 from the Municipal Fiber Grant Program to partially fund the SCADA Fiber Optic Upgrade or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 20 To see if the District will transfer from the System Development Fund the sum of \$80,000.00 to partially fund the SCADA Fiber Optic Upgrade or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 21 To see if the District will transfer from the System Development Fund the sum of \$330,000.00 for the SCADA Upgrade Fiber Optic Fund or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 22 To see if the District will transfer from the System Development Fund the sum of \$50,000.00 for the SCADA Upgrade Fiber Optic Consulting Fund or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 23 To see if the District will transfer from the E&D (Free Cash) the sum of \$20,000.00 for the Rate/Sustainability Study Fund or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 24 To see if the District will transfer from the System Development Fund the sum of \$25,000.00 for the Mag Meters Fund or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 25 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$70,000.00 for the Lead Copper Rule Improvement Fund or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 26 To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$25,000.00 for the SCADA Computer Software Fund or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 27 To see if the District will transfer from the E&D (Free Cash) the sum of \$150,000.00 for the Broadway Well Fields Test Fund or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 30 To see if the District will vote to exempt the balance of Free Cash from the Provisions of Section 12A of Chapter 151 of the Acts of 1979 and that such Free Cash not to be utilized for the purpose of reducing the property tax for Fiscal Year 2026/2027 or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 31 To see if the District will vote to authorize the District Treasurer, with the approval of the Water Commissioners, to borrow in anticipation of the revenue for the twelve month period beginning July 1, 2026 in accordance with General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 4, and acts in amended thereof, and including in addition thereof, Chapter 849 of the Acts of 1969. as amended and renew any note or notes as they may be given for a period of less than one year in accordance with General Laws, Chapter 44. Section 17.


And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copies thereof at two or more places in the District at least seven (7) days before the time of the meeting.

HEREOF FAIL, NOT, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon to the District Clerk at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid.
